- Central Park restroom Floor plumbing has been completed and backfilled. Floor concrete has been poured. Next step is for walls to go up. Completion date is still scheduled for end of May.

- Getting bids on Sunset Park shelter roofs. We have 4 shingle roofs left to replace with metal roofs. Hoping to do complete this spring as budget allows.
