### Donald Wyman Crab (Small)

Height: 15-20' Spread: 15-20' Shape: Round Foliage: Glossy green leaves, Fragrant white flowers, red fruit Exposure: Full Sun The Don Wyman Crab is best grown in medium moisture, well drained, acidic loam, in full sun. An excellent disease-resistent tree, and has upright form becoming rounded in maturity.



#### Stellar Pink Dogwood (Small)

Height: 15-20' Spread: 15-20' Shape: Small tree for lawns and wooded areas Foliage: Soft pink flowers in late May Fall Foliage: Fall colors of purple-red Exposure: Full sun

Due to its size, the Stellar Pink Dogwood makes an oustanding tree for near structures, planting among shade trees or anywhere in the garden.



### Honeycrisp Apple (Small)

Height: 12-15' Spread: 12-15' Shape: Rounded Foliage: Green Pollination: Requires another apple variety that blooms at the same time

Exposure: Full Sun

The Honeycrisp Apple Tree is compact, great for small spaces and exceptionally cold-hardy. Superior fresh flavor makes this apple an American favorite.



#### Reliance Peach (Small)

Height: 12-15' Spread: 12-15' Shape: Round Foliage: Green Exposure:
Full sun Self pollinating

Peaches ripen in mid-August. Yields a large freestone peach with yellow flesh and red-orange skin. Very little work is required to maintain this tree. Excellent flavor.



#### Serbian Spruce (Medium)

Height: 50-60' Spread: 20-25 Shape: Pyramidal Foliage: Evergreen year around Exposure: Full Sun

The Serbian Spruce Tree is a tall and slender tree, with graceful upswept branches. It has glossy, dark green needles with slender streaks of white and distinctive cones. Great for browsers, nesting and songbirds.



### Canaan Fir (Medium)

Height: 45-60' Spread: 25-35' Shape: Pyramidal Foliage: Dark green Fall Foliage: Evergreen Exposure: Full Sun

Canaan fir is an attractive medium-sized evergreen tree exhibiting a relatively dense, pyramidal crown with a slender spire-like tip that often imparts a formal appearance. Foliage color is dark green to bluish-green with silvery stomatic bands on the underside of its needles. Can be used in the landscape as a screen or accent tree due to its formal appearance.



# Skyline Honeylocust Tree (Large)

Height: 40-50' Spread: 30-40' Shape: Pryamidal Foliage: Medium

green Exposure: Full sun

## Tulip Tree (Large)

Height: 60-90' Spread: 30-50' Shape: Pyramidal to broad conical

Foliage: Large 4-lobed green leaves Fall Foliage: Golden yellow

Exposer: Full Sun

This deciduous tree trunk may reach 4 to 6 feet in diameter. Named and noted for cup-shaped, tulip-like yellow flowers that bloom in the spring. Flowers are followed by cone-shaped brown fruits, each bearing numerous winged seeds.



## Pacific Brilliance Pin Oak (Large)

Height: 45-50' Spread: 20-25' Shape: Upright Foliage: Green with

yellow fall colors Exposure: Full Sun

The Pacific Brillance Pin Oak is a moderately-large sized oak tree with an even and attractive crown. This oak doesn't produce as many acorns, and are loved by squirrels.



### Regal Prince Oak Tree (Large)

Height: 40-60' Spread: 20-25' Shape: Pyramidal Foliage: Green

fern-like Fall Foliage: Golden yellow Exposure: Full sun

The Regal Prince Oak is tidy, formal and dense, with strong upright crown growth and dominant central leader. Leaves are bright green and shiny on top and silvery gray underneath at the base. Narrow acorns turn lime green and can be quite attractive. Drought tolerant and can withstand road salt.



## Swamp White Oak Tree (Large)

Height: 50-60' Spread: 50-60' Shape: Broad, round, upright Fall

Foliage: Green Exposure: Full Sun

The Swamp White Oak is a striking tree with attractive peeling bark. The lustrous, lobed leaves have a two-tone appearance, dark green on top with a silvery white underside. Fall color is an orange-gold to yellow in mid-autumn. An excellent shade tree for any landscape.
