# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CHARGES AND FEES FOR CITY CEMETERIES

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to increase cemetery revenues to provide for more resources to care for the City's cemeteries and to reduce the burden being placed on property tax payers; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 115.09 of the Municipal Code of the City of Washington, Iowa provides that the City Council may adopt by Resolution rules and regulations, including fees for services, with regards to the City's cemeteries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, IOWA, that the City Council hereby:

- 1. Authorizes the fee for administration services shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).
- 2. Authorizes the fee for interments which occur on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays shall be one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) in addition to the fee for regular weekday interments.

The Washington Chamber of Commerce Visitors & Tourism Committee would like to thank the Washington City Council for their generous donation of \$10,000 to the committee this past fiscal year. We would like to take this opportunity to update the Council on what the committee has been doing this past year to promote Washington.

#### **Memberships/Networking Opportunities**

- The committee has continued to maintain full membership in Iowa Group Travel Association. We now receive all bus tour leads from travel shows group leaders attend in Iowa. The cost for membership dues was \$200.
- The committee has continued our membership in Eastern Iowa Tourism Association at a cost of \$165. We have attended three of their Education/Networking meetings. The cost to attend EITA meetings was approximately \$579. We have received 19 visitor leads from 13 states, in which information packets were mailed.
- We continue to send to Welcome Packets to new & prospective City residents.

#### **Advertising/Marketing Opportunities**

- The committee continues to have presence in the Eastern Iowa Tourism Association book with a ¼ page ad. Total cost for the ad was \$200.
- The committee placed ads in the Kalona Tourism Guide promoting Washington events. Cost: \$675.
- The Chamber also will be represented at the statewide Iowa Group Travel Association (IGTA) meeting in Des Moines on February 1, representing the Chamber and promoting the City of Washington. The cost of this will be approximately \$535.
- Local ads promoting events and tourism total cost: \$800.
- Advertising Washington events in *Iowa Today*, total cost, approximately \$200.
- The new updated edition of the *Washington, Iowa Community Profile* magazine was available in May 2010. More than 1,800 of the 5,000 have already been distributed. An electronic version is now available.

#### **Marketing the Community/County**

- The committee continued to promote a Self-Guided Cemetery Tour. The brochure was printed for us at no cost.
- The committee is working with the local motels to promote Sunset Park. We purchased and provided at no charge to motel guests passes to the Aquatic Center. Total Cost--\$300. The motels also have Frisbee golf discs that the committee provided at no charge.
- The committee is working with the local motels to promote the Community Y. We will continue to provide, at no charge to motel guests, passes to the Y.
- The committee continues to track class reunions and provides them with Washington books.

- The committee produced a Washington bag to use as a welcome to visitors. The bag holds marketing materials and coupons for local businesses appropriate to each group. Some of the groups included: Railroad Club swap meet, bus tours and class reunions.
- The committee has updated and continues to enhance the Chamber website Tourism Section.
- We mailed out Barn Quilt postcards as a follow-up to the above shows. In the past, this follow-up has usually resulted in one or more inquiries for tours.

#### **Special Events**

- The committee had a joint booth with Barn Quilts of Washington County and Main Street Washington at the 2011 Washington County Fair promoting Washington. Cost: \$120.
- The committee has developed a brochure that promotes the replica of the world record holding 33 foot cornstalk, grown by Don Radda, at the Fairgrounds.
- The Committee had a booth at the second annual Senior Fair at the Washington County Hospital and Clinics in October.
- The annual Chamber sponsored Craft Show continues to attract tourists to the City. More than 67% of the participating 92 vendors were from outside of Washington County, and of that, 34% were from 3 neighboring states.

#### **Upcoming**

- The committee is working with the Video Production class of Washington High School and two students, Alex Thode and Brock Kimball, who are making the final touches on a video highlighting the City of Washington. It will be ready before the end of January and segments of it will appear on YouTube.
- Relocation of a Round Barn to the County Fair grounds in 2011.
- The committee is exploring the possibility of working with the Pork Procures and other groups to have a community/county wide event later this calendar year.
- We stand ready to welcome and prepare for a *possible* RAGBRAI route through Southeast Iowa that will be announced later this month.

The committee continues to find our biggest challenge to be educating local residents about available opportunities. Tourism encourages people to shop Washington, enjoy Washington's friendliness, eat in Washington, stay in Washington and attend Washington events. This is an important process implementing the Visitors & Tourism mission statement, "The mission of the Visitors & Tourism Committee is to create a climate of hospitality, and inform and showcase to residents and visitors the special places and events in the Washington area."

This is not a complete listing of all the Visitors & Tourism Committee did in the past year, but we wanted to give you what we think are the highlights along with some dollar figures, so you

can see that the money you grant to us has been put to good use. We are very excited about what this committee has done and the future of tourism in Washington County. We would like to request that city funding for the important component of marketing and promoting tourism opportunities continue, ideally in the requested amount of \$10,000 level of support. Thank you for your past support and we look forward to the future of Washington!!

Dear Washington City Council and Mayor:

PAWS & More thanks you for your support and for your service to the city of Washington. Hopefully you are all aware of the many services PAWS provides the city, but two worth mentioning are the Youth Program and the Pet Therapy Program. Over 300 kids throughout the county attended our youth training course. This has resulted in many new volunteers and most importantly, kids that are now educated on proper animal care and management. This makes for a safer community today and in our future. The Youth Program, along with the weekly Pet Therapy Program where PAWS visits nursing homes throughout the county, have been widely received. PAWS desperately wants to continue these programs. This takes funding. We hope you'll consider this factor when making your budget decisions.

PAWS took in 67 Washington City dog pound dogs in 2010. We will submit an invoice for reimbursement for:  $67 \log_3 x \$40$  (your cost of euthanasia per dog) = \$2,680. These dogs are NOT included in the numbers below.

We received 737 in 2010, with 205 of them from the city of Washington. That number consists of the 13 dogs that were not from the pound, 188 cats, and 4 rabbits. Because of our work, you can see that the number of cats is down significantly from previous years — spaying and neutering works!

If figuring like other cities within the county, the "formula" works as follows: number of animals accepted from within the city of Washington only, times a current LESS-THAN-county-average daily boarding fee of \$12.50, times the first seven days we have the animal in our care. The seven day time period is state law for how long an impounded animal is to be kept prior to adoption or euthanasia.

This calculates to: 205 city animals  $x $12.50 \times 7 \text{ days} = $17,937.50$ . We are also asking for reimbursement for the number of pick-ups we provided city animals at \$25 per call x 20 calls = \$500. The majority of these calls, if not all, came from the Safety Center. This fee helps cover our cost to pick up these animals — gas, mileage, and staff time away from shelter duties. The total of these figure are \$18,437.50.

Please provide funding to PAWS & More Animal Shelter in your 2011-2012 budget in the amount of \$18,437.50.

Re: Health Insurance

#### <u>ISSUE</u>

Consider renewal of health insurance plan with Wellmark Blue Cross/Blue Shield.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City offers health insurance benefits to full-time employees through Wellmark Blue Cross/Blue Shield. Employees do not contribute for single coverage. Employees receiving family coverage pay 25 percent of the premium through payroll deductions. The plan year begins March 1.

Wellmark has offered to renew the plan at a 1.88% <u>reduction</u>. Next year's monthly premium will be \$507 for single coverage and \$1,268 for family. The City budgeted a premium increase of ten percent.

Our agent, Terrie Copler with True North, told me that this premium reduction is unusual. She says most of her clients' renewals are increases.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Approve renewing the City's health insurance policy with Wellmark Blue Cross/Blue Shield.

- **WWTP lagoon** The lagoon is pumping down at press time.
- **Digester boiler** The boiler quit running on 14<sup>th</sup>. The boiler is used to heat the digester control room and warm the bio-solids to a temp of 98-99 degrees for stabilization. Leet Refrigeration had to replace several major components inside the control panel to get the boiler to burn. The boiler was back in service by the 22<sup>nd</sup>. The cost of this repair will be very expensive.
- **Digester recirculation** (**recirc**) **pump** Jason went to Electric Pump Company (EPC) in Des Moines on Jan 10<sup>th</sup>, to pick up the new recirc pump so we could install it in-house. EPC quoted us a price of \$3000-\$4000 for them to install it. We had to change some piping and install two (2) new four (4) inch valves to get it plumbed into the recirc line. Leet came on the 11<sup>th</sup>, to power up the pump which is wired into the digester boiler control panel. The new recirc was in service by noon. The digester was back to normal operation at that time, too.
- WWTP December 2010 MOR 1/31 days bypass over lagoon standpipe, 47.628 million gallons (mg) treated, 47.296 mg through WWTP, 0.332 mg in and out of lagoon. Average daily flow 1.536 mg, maximum daily flow 1.857 mg, minimum daily flow 1.168 mg, Sunset Park lift station bypassed for a total of 38.0 hours. No SSO's out of the head works building for December 2010. Removal/ 85% required CBOD5= 91% Total Suspended Solids= 90%
