Cemetery Rates Comparison Summary

After collecting data of current rates being charged by other cemeteries in Iowa, both City owned and operated, and privately owned and operated, we have compiled a comparison chart to show all rates. Based on the information that we have collected, it would appear that our charges are in the middle range of those surveyed. One area that we may need to look at is weekend charges. It seems as most cemeteries have begun charging an additional fee for Saturday afternoon services, above the Saturday morning charge to make up for the employee overtime they are paying. Additionally, they are for the most part not allowing Sunday interments and holiday interments only during the week (if holiday falls on weekend, no interments on that day are allowed). There is a wide range of lot prices depending on cemeteries, but most interment charges are similar.

Elm Grove and Woodlawn are slightly lower than average on lot prices (\$50-75), way below average on columbarium prices (\$500-600) and above average on infant lot prices (\$120). Adult full size interments are slightly below average on all days (\$25). Cremains interments are slightly above average on all days (\$60). Infant interments are about \$150 above average across all days. Columbarium interments are about \$75.00 above average on all days. Disinterments are average across all types. Some cemeteries do not allow after hours, while some charge up to \$300 per hour. Some cemeteries have started charging a "winter charge" for additional work such as snow removal, extra time opening graves due to frost in the ground, etc. These winter charges average around \$100.00. Some cemeteries have additional charges if the interred person is not a resident (either a percentage or flat fee).

Re: Fall Cleanup Planning

As the Council is aware, it has been discussed to bring back the annual fall cleanup, but to handle this as a central site collection rather than a curbside collection as has been done in the past. The Council allocated \$9,000 to this end in the FY16 budget.

Having done some research on this subject, I have weighed a number of questions, including but not limited to:

- Where should the central site be located?
- How should the cleanup be staffed?
- What charges should apply and how should this cash be handled?
- When should the cleanup take place and what days of the week?

I have found a good example to build off, with the cleanup done by the City of Vinton. They have been doing this for a number of years, and have developed what sounds like a very effective process. Vinton has a site that is fenced, and the cleanup event takes place over a weekend. Residents are charged a gate fee, and also have to pay fees for disposal of such things as electronics, TVs, appliances, etc. The City staffs the cleanup, and outside vendors bring in roll off dumpsters for trash, as well as separate dumpsters for the additional disposal items listed in my previous sentence. For your information, I have attached the flyer produced for their cleanup event last year. I think Vinton's basic concept could work well for us, with a few adjustments.

Location of Site

We only have a few feasible alternatives for site if we want to have an area that is fenced for security over the course of a multi-day event. The wastewater plant/yard waste site is probably the best site. I can see us being able to set up a very nice traffic flow through the area, it is an area people are used to coming to for the yard waste site, and it is nicely fenced. The only other options I could come up with are the area to the south of the water plant (which is not fenced) and the County Recycling Center (which doesn't have much space to spare and could be a zoo with lots of out of town residents there also). We are planning to fence the area south of the water plant when the plant upgrades are done, so that could be a more feasible site a few years down the road.

Staffing for the Cleanup

I really like Vinton's idea of having the City staff the event. They typically have 3 employees on site, and have a backhoe and an end loader available. I would probably also add a clerical employee to assist throughout the cleanup to take money and provide for proper accounting. I believe we could save on the overall cost by using this model. I have talked with JJ, Fred, and Kelsey about these staffing ideas and believe everyone is supportive.

Charges for Service

I'm not crazy about having a gate fee, but do think that charges should apply for items that require a charge to be picked up, such as electronics. We won't know exactly what these charges should be until we get vendors lined up for each category, but we could then have stickers produced for each type of item and begin selling these in advance of the cleanup, as well as on cleanup day. Having stickers would be a good control, as the staff handling appliances, for example, would know not to take something that didn't have a sticker.

Cleanup Dates

I think we had discussed doing this event in October. I think we need to keep things a little bit open on exact dates, because we will need to coordinate with various vendors to find an acceptable timeframe. I do have a list of the vendors that the SEMCO Landfill uses, and also have some ideas from Vinton as well. I like the idea of doing the cleanup over a weekend, but would probably opt for a Friday/Saturday rather than a Saturday/Sunday if given the choice. If we did something like 12-8 on Friday and 8-4 on Saturday, that would seem to give ample time for people to bring their items out.

I look forward to discussion at the meeting.




