




Community Health Improvement Plan





City of Washington City Council Election




City of Washington City Council Election Information

Now is the time to submit paperwork to be on the ballot in November.

The City of Washington will have three city council seats on the ballot November 7, 2023.

Paperwork is available for pickup at City Hall - 215 E. Washington Street.
Deadline to file completed forms at City Hall is Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 5p.m.



The three seats on this ballot will be:

- Ward 1 Northwest
- Ward 3 Southeast
- At-Large Citywide

Are you interested in running for City Council? Now is the time to submit paperwork to be on the ballot in November.

Candidates are able to pick up nomination forms at City Hall and they should be returned to City Hall by 5 p.m. September 21st.

The Mayor and Council members are elected for staggered, four-year terms. Four of the Council members are elected from geographic wards, and two are elected at-large.
