To Whom It May Concern:

Construction for the City of Washington N. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Improvements project is underway. The following contains general information regarding the project:

- 1) N. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. near the intersection of E. 7<sup>th</sup> St. is currently completely closed to traffic. This intersection is anticipated to be reopened on or about Monday August 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 2) The Contractor, Cornerstone Excavating, Inc. (CEI), is currently working on sanitary sewer near the railroad tracks on N. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- 3) Water main installation is complete along the west side of N. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. There may be minor water service interruptions as services are switched over from the old to the new main.
- 4) It is anticipated that N. 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue may be closed either partially or completely from E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street through the summer and into the fall. At times, N. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. will be completely closed. Residents on N. 4<sup>th</sup> between E. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. and E. 7<sup>th</sup> St. will need to use alley or side street access to their property during these times. Through traffic should avoid N. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. in this area if possible. Please observe and follow all traffic control/detour signs.
- 5) Residents should continue to put their garbage and recycling receptacles out at their normal location and time/day of the week. CEI or the garbage service will pick up receptacles at their normal location. In some instances, receptacles will be transported to be emptied. If this happens, all receptacles will be tagged and returned to their normal location within the day.
