<u>Annual Dinner</u> – Help plan, implement, and evaluate the Chamber's largest member event in partnership with WEDG and Main Street Washington.

• Committee meets winter through spring. Dinner is scheduled Monday, March 25, 2024. (Board Member Rep(s): Mary & Sam)

Golf Committee – Help plan, boost sponsorships, and promote fun golf tournaments in the community.
