Attached is the Stewart school pay application. I was hoping this would be our final, except for the retainage, but it appears that Neumiller, the electrical sub, still has a small amount of work to do. The attached pay application includes 75% of their work. There are a couple extra things included.

- 1. The City asked (and Jeff Brock with the school approved) for us to bill the street patch through the contract. I believe the City has arranged to reimburse the School somehow. The cost for that was 292 SY \times \$65 = \$18,980
- 2. There was 33 SY of paving added on the south side of the school. The cost for that is 33 SY \times \$54 = \$1782



MAINTENANCE & CONSTRUCTION DEPT. REPORT 4-2-22/4-15-22

STREETS: Personnel cold mixed some potholes using 3 ton. The street sweeper cont'd to operate around town.

WATER DISTRIBUTION: Personnel finished up the water service repair at Marshall's Furniture. Personnel turned many waters on/off for different reasons (plumbers & snow birds mainly).

SEWER COLLECTION: Personnel jetted, televised and excavated a sewer main located at South 6th Ave-East Jefferson, a clay line that is collapsing. Crews excavated and repaired two places on the line.

Jetting took place on West Buchanan for contractor purposes, including televising the newly installed sanitary sewer. Jetting also took place between South 2nd Ave & South Iowa south of East Harrison St, for K&S

STORM SEWER COLLECTION: Personnel NA

(Alliant contractor) to televise re:gas line installation.

MECHANIC/SHOP: Personnel serviced 303 (noise problem-front brakes), 504, PD Trailblazer, FD #4 (batteries), FD #2 (alternator), 105 (material for bed side boards), WWTP dog truck, WTP Explorer to Mincer (recall), 611, 111 (replaced reverse light & hydraulic lines), 003 (rear view mirror install), PD 009, small engines, 119 (took out salt spreader) and fuel report.

OTHER: Personnel hauled rock to the storage bins. Personnel responded to 67 One Call Locates. Yard waste route cont'd. Personnel hauled dirt to the new pavilion (Stewart-6 loads) in the Wellness Park. Two personnel attended a training session and certification class for concrete testing (PCC level 1).

WATER DISTRIBUTION: Personnel installed a 1 inch water service at the new pavilion inside the Wellness Park for a drinking fountain/bottle refill/dog bowl water, plus installed a drain into an 8 inch storm line to that same fountain. Personnel had 14 water shut offs for nonpayment. Personnel performed a 1 inch water service for the Halcyon House newly constructed raised gardens off of South Ave B.

SEWER COLLECTION: Personnel continued & finished the 8 inch sanitary sewer on Meadowview Lane after laying 150 ft of pipe and installing a manhole. Personnel also jetted and flushed numerous sewer lines where there were issues with service lines. Jetted and flushed areas for K&S to televise sewer mains to locate services for new gas line installs.

STORM SEWER COLLECTION: Personnel replaced a curb casting intake with a driveway approach casting on Campbell Drive in Oakwood subdivision.

MECHANIC/SHOP: Personnel took two pieces of equipment (old leaf vac & crack sealer) plus 302 a 1996 Ford 250 to the scrap yard netting \$1,400. Personnel serviced M/C Tanker, WWTP truck, 305 (recall), 337, 301, PD 307 (door hinges), FD #1 and 105 (sideboards/painted).

OTHER: Personnel responded to 87 One Call Locates. Yard waste pick up continued. Personnel assisted with the grinding of the yard waste and brush pile, consisting of 12 hours. Personnel assisted the Parks Dept in taking down the Xmas lights and the cover off of the Central Park fountain. Picked up appliances for spring clean up and assisted the WWTP during spring cleanup.

 once a week, share and go over the information with everyone.

- WWTP Mowing-We have started mowing at the WWTP and the 3 lift stations in town.
- Tree Trimming-We have been doing a lot of tree trimming at the WWTP along with the removal of a few trees. Along with all of the trimming we mulched around all trees and buildings.
- Old WWTP Demo-The fence company is to start on May 2nd then DeLong will final grade and seed.
- E-Coli Testing-May will be our first round of three rounds of E-Coli testing.
- City wide cleanup-Clean up was held April 23rd at the WWTP from 7-11a.m. We had 5 city staff and the Johnson County crew working and went very well. Approximately 285 cars came trough.



Re: A.C.E. Signature Homes Development Agreement

Specific language has been added to this development agreement to offer protection to the City. Specifically, on page 4, giving A.C.E. Signature Homes 36 months to construct, with 4 units each year. They are to market these lots for sale also. Additionally, the lots can not be sold for more than market value of other new construction lots in Washington.

Also, a unit is complete when a certificate of occupancy is issued. A.C.E. Signature Homes must provide at least 3 days' notice and at least 1 week prior to closing for the final inspection to receive a certificate of occupancy.

Also, once a deed for the lot has been signed, a home must be built within 18 months.

If 4 homes are not constructed within each year, A.C.E. Signature Homes must pay the City \$10,000 per unit. If this amount is not paid within 30 days of the shortfall, they would need to repay the city the entire \$800,000.

Due to these extra stipulations, I would recommend that the City Council approve this development agreement with A.C.E. Signature Homes.

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined that entering into the Development Agreement with the Developer is in the best interests of the citizens of the City.

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the aforementioned Development Agreement, attached to this Resolution.

DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, City is the owner of that certain property legally described as Lots 10 through 21, NLW Subdivision, Plat 2, Washington, Iowa (the "the Plat 2 Property"), said Plat being attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC desires to purchase the Plat 2 property; and,

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to sell the Plat 2 Property to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC for a purchase price of \$310,000; and

WHEREAS, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC intends to construct residential units on a portion of the Plat 2 Property and will be the real estate broker to sell the remaining portion of the Plat 2 Property to other homebuilders; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to sell the Plat 2 Property to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC for the construction of residential housing units in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, ON THE BASIS OF THE PRECEDING RECITALS, AND FOR THE MUTUAL CONSIDERATION OF ENTERING INTO THIS AGREEMENT, THE DEVELOPER AND CITY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

A. Real Estate Closing for Plat 2 Property.

- 1. **Purchase Price.** A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC shall pay the sum of \$310,000.00 for the purchase of the Plat 2 Property, subject to deductions allowed in Section (A)(9) below. A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC shall place \$3,000 of earnest money into their trust account for the purchase.
- 2. **Real Estate Taxes.** City shall pay real estate taxes that are due and a pro-rata share of all of the real estate taxes that have accrued as of the date of closing.
- 3. **Risk of Loss and Insurance.** City shall bear the risk of loss or damage to the Plat 2 Property prior to closing and possession. City agrees to maintain existing insurance and A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC may purchase additional insurance.
- 4. **Possession and Closing.** If A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC timely performs all of its obligations, possession of the Plat 2 Property shall be delivered to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC on or before October 7, 2022, and any adjustments for rent, insurance, interest and all charges attributable to Owner's possession shall be made as of the date of possession. Closing shall occur after the approval of title by A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC pursuant to Paragraph 6 below. Owner shall permit the City to inspect the property prior to closing to assure that the Property is in the condition required by this Agreement. If possession is given on a day other than the closing, the parties shall make a separate agreement with adjustments as of the date of possession. This transaction shall be considered closed upon delivery of the title transfer documents to City and receipt of all funds then due at closing from the City under this Agreement.
- 5. **Condition of Property.** The Property as of the date of this Agreement will be preserved by City in its present condition until closing. City makes no warranties, express or implied, as to the condition of the Property. A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC acknowledges that it is purchasing the Plat 2 Property in an "AS IS" condition.
- 6. Abstract and Title. City, at City's expense, shall deliver to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC, at City's expense an abstract of title to the Plat 2 Property continued through the date of acceptance of this Agreement. It shall show marketable title in City in conformity with this Agreement, Iowa law and title standards of the Iowa Bar Association. City shall make every reasonable effort to promptly perfect title. If closing is delayed due to City's inability to provide marketable title, this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect until either party rescinds the Agreement after giving ten days written notice to the other party. The abstract shall become property of the A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC when the Purchase Price is paid in full and the Closing occurs. City shall pay the costs of additional abstracting and title work due to any act or omission of City, including transfers by or the death of City or assignees. The abstract shall be

obtained from an abstracter qualified by the Guaranty Division of the Iowa Housing Finance Authority.

- The Environmental Matters. City warrants to the best of their knowledge and belief that there are no abandoned wells, solid waste disposal sites, hazardous wastes or substances, or underground storage tanks located on the Plat 2 Property, the Plat 2 Property does not contain levels of radon gas, asbestos or urea-formaldehyde foam insulation which require remediation under current governmental standards, and City has done nothing to contaminate the Plat 2 Property with hazardous wastes or materials. City warrants that the Plat 2 Property is not subject to any local, state or federal judicial or administrative action, investigation or order, as the case may be, regarding wells, solid waste disposal sites, hazardous wastes or substances, or underground storage tanks. In the event that there exists any hazardous materials or substances, solid waste disposal sites or underground storage tanks on the Plat 2 Property, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC has the right to cancel this Agreement. If any abandoned wells exist, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC may require City to cap the well in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- 8. **Deed.** Upon payment of the Purchase Price, City shall convey the Property to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC by Warranty Deed, free and clear of all liens, restrictions, and encumbrances except easements and restrictions of record. General warranties of the title shall extend to the time of delivery of the deed excepting liens and encumbrances permitted by the City. City shall prepare the deed for signature by City at the closing.
- 9. **Use of Purchase Price.** At time of settlement, funds of the Purchase Price may be used to pay taxes and other liens, payoff the current real estate contract and to acquire outstanding interests, if any, of others. City shall pay the real estate transfer tax associated with this transaction and A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC shall pay the costs of recording the documents.

B. Developer's Obligations.

1. The parties to this Agreement agree that the Purchase Price for each lot in the Plat 2 Property is as follows:

Lot 10: \$24,000

Lot 11: \$21,000

Lot 12: \$21,000

Lot 13: \$21,000

Lot 14: \$21,000

Lot 15: \$20,000

Lot 16: \$22,000 Lot 17: \$32,000 Lot 18: \$32,000 Lot 19: \$28,000 Lot 20: \$34,000 Lot 21: \$34,000

A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC may cause residential units to be constructed on any of the lots in the Plat 2 Property and will be responsible for marketing and selling the remaining lots that A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC will not build upon in the Plat 2 Property, with the goal of having all twelve (12) lots fully built out within thirty-six (36) months of the date of this Agreement, as follows:

For its services in marketing the remaining lots, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC may sell each lot for no more than fair market value of other new construction lots selling in Washington.

- 2. Covenants upon sale. On the lots that A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC is constructing in the Plat 2 Property, A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC, shall construct said houses and have a residential dwelling(s) on said lots within thirty-six (36) months of the date on the deed conveying the lots to A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC. As part of every sale made by A.C.E. Signature Homes, LLC of the remaining lots in the Plat 2 Property, as part of said deed, there shall be a covenant that requires a residential dwelling(s) be constructed on each lot within eighteen (18) months of the date of the deed. For purposes of this paragraph 2, the residential dwelling will be completed on the earlier of listing the house for sale or persons moving into said residential dwelling(s). The overall goal of the City is to have all of the lots built upon within thirty-six (36) months from the date of this Agreement.
- 3. For purposes of this Agreement, a unit is deemed completed when a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the City for an individual unit and a five-foot sidewalk has been constructed across all lot frontages. The City must be contacted at least three business days and at least one (1) week prior to closing before a final inspection is to be schedule in order to receive a certificate of occupancy.
- 4. Failure of the Developer to meet the completed development within the timeframe set forth above in Item 1shall be deemed a material breach of this Agreement. The City shall have the authority to waive the default fee listed in Section B (B) below for one (1) year, on the

condition that the foundation has been poured and the framing has been completed and all building permits have been received and approved.

- 5. The obligation to construct the required number of units over thirty-six (36) months shall remain a lien on the Development Property until released by the City. When enough homes have been built that generates enough tax dollars to meet the debt obligation of \$800,000 bond, said determination to be made in the sole opinion of the City, the remaining units shall not be subject to the lien outlined in this agreement.
- 6. Developer shall be required to list all lots for sale with a for sale sign and contact information as soon as the improvements have been completed or sooner if desired.
- 7. As part of this Agreement, the Developer expressly agrees that all lots will be available to all builders who desire to purchase a lot in the Development Property.

C. City's obligations.

- 1. In recognition of the Developer's investment in the Development Property for the Construction of residential housing, the City agrees as follows:
 - a) The City shall construct in strict compliance with Chapter 26 of the Code of Iowa, the municipal improvements to be located on the Property which are shown on the plans designed by Garden & Associates Engineers, said plan set dated ______ (the "Improvement Project").
 - b) The City shall adopt appropriate plans, amendments and ordinances, pursuant to Chapter 403 of the Code of Iowa, to place the Development Property into an appropriate Urban Renewal Area of the City as determined by the Washington City Council.
 - c) Prior to the completion of the Improvements, the City shall take all necessary steps to issue financing in the amount of not-to-exceed \$800,000, said financing shall be secured within thirty (30) days of acceptance of the Improvements Project and on terms acceptable to the City.

D. Default by Developer: repayment.

Because the City is making the economic development grant to the Developer based upon a schedule of new residential units to be constructed, any deviation from the schedule outlined in Section (B)(1) above will be deemed a default of this Agreement. If the Developer fails to complete the required number of units at the end of the calendar year, the City will provide

written notice to the Developer to cure said default by the end of the proceeding calendar year. In the event that the Developer fails to cure the default by the end of the calendar year, the Developer shall repay to the City, the amount of \$10,000 per unit which has not been completed, but was required by the schedule. (By way of example, if the Developer has only completed 2 units by the end of calendar year 2023, received notice to cure, and has only completed 6 units by the end of calendar year 2024, the Developer's shortfall is two (2) units.) Therefore, the Developer shall, within thirty (30) days of the determination of the Developer's shortfall, shall pay \$10,000 per unit to the City. The failure of the Developer to pay the Developer's shortfall shall allow the City, in its sole discretion, to declare a default of the entire agreement and require that the entire \$800,000 be repaid to the City, less \$10,000 credit for each unit that has been completed at the time of the default of the entire agreement.

E. Administrative Provisions.

- 1. Each party represents to the other that the party has full power and authority to enter into this Agreement and that this Agreement is a binding Agreement duly authorized by the governing body of each party.
- 2. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be amended or assigned without the express permission of the other party.
- 3. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties.
- 4. This Agreement shall be deemed to be a contract made under the laws of the State of Iowa, and for all purposes shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Iowa.
- 5. If any provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be invalid, illegal or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of this Agreement and the application thereof shall not be affected and shall be enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- 6. Except for the obligations of a Party to pay monies then due and payable under this Agreement, the obligation of any Party to perform any acts hereunder shall be suspended during the period such performance is prevented by acts of God, war, riot, invasion, fire and accident.
 - 7. That this Agreement may be executed in counterparts.

Background







Re: Driveway grade issues at 1408 E. Main Street

At this location the driveway has considerable slope currently and with the water main project, it is going to increase this slope, which the property owners are not happy with. We could remove additional driveway to the north to reduce the slope, but the property owners are not happy about this option either since it reduces their flat spot in front of the garage. The street could be raised, but the entire street should be raised and that is not a good option for the project since it would greatly increase costs. Another option, and the one that seems the best, is to remove the sidewalk from this segment to 15th and to stop the sidewalk just west of the alley. This will also help alleviate drainage issues on their property following the project.

Based on the information from our engineer and discussion with our engineering tech, the removal of this sidewalk section is the most cost-effective option.
