<u>Annual Dinner</u> – Help plan, implement, and evaluate the Chamber's largest member event in partnership with WEDG and Main Street Washington. Committee meets from winter through spring. Dinner is scheduled Monday, February 27th, 2023.

<u>Chamber Golf Events</u> – Help plan, boost sponsorships, and promote a fun golf tournament to the community.

Meetings are every few weeks from April - Sept. The 2022 tournaments are scheduled for June 15<sup>th</sup> (Ladies') & June 16<sup>th</sup> (Men's), 2023. Fall tournament: Birdies, Beer & Brats scheduled for September 2023.

<u>Government Relations</u> – Help plan and implement the Legislative Briefings, Candidates Forum and Day at the Capitol. Meetings are scheduled according to the elections with contested races.

<u>Ridiculous Day Committee</u> – Part of Washington's multiple day summer kick-off event. Featuring: family games, parade, and retail promotions. Help to plan, prepare, promote, and run parts of the event. Event is the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday in June. Committee will meet monthly from March- June. The 2023 event is scheduled for June 3rd.

<u>Tour of Homes</u> – Recruit homes to be featured during the Chamber's annual Tour of Homes on the 1<sup>st</sup> weekend in December. Homes are decorated for the holidays and will feature architecture, new construction, remodels, and holiday spirit. Volunteers needed to help solicit homes for the tour, orientate the home owners, and volunteer for part of the weekend's event.

Meetings are once a month from September – January. The 2022 Tour of Homes will be December 2nd & 3rd.

<u>Member Support Grant</u>—Local business assistance for Chamber members facing economic challenges or in need of temporary financial relief. Members sponsoring this fund at a level of \$500 or more will be on the advisory committee for the disbursement of these funds.

<u>Artfest</u>— Events to celebrate arts in Washington. The committee plans to auction remnants from the Captain's Table that have been repurposed. The auction will be held in conjunction with a dinner in Central Park honoring the Captain's Tale menu. We will continue to plan projects to raise money for future murals in our community.
