Washington South 15th Avenue Improvements Project Construction Update 9/13/19

Water main and storm sewer structures and mains are completed. This week the contractor is working on rough grade, the sub drain tile and rocking the site between Washington and Madison. This has been challenging as the contractor has had to work on short sections at a time, in order to afford us the ability to restore access to driveways within the same day. Thanks to DeLong for putting forth the extra effort. This work will continue into the first part of next week. The remainder of the week similar construction will be completed on the section between Madison and Adams.

Next week, Alliant Energy will be on site to install a new gas main from Washington to Madison along 15th. This is being done because it was found that the existing gas main was not deep enough to maintain cover with the elevation of the new road. Property owners will experience an outage of their gas services while Alliant is hooking up the new services. This outage is expected to be a short amount of time. Mediacom is scheduled in Monday and Tuesday to finish their utility work. After Mediacom is completed, Alliant can remove the old power poles. This leads us into the paving portion of the project which is scheduled as of now to start on Monday the 23rd.
